This [survey](#) will gather insights from young people and built environment professionals in Commonwealth about what's needed to ensure young people are actively involved in shaping their communities through Planning.

With a combined population of 2.4 billion where 1 in 3 young people aged between 15 and 29 live in Commonwealth countries, it is very important that young people are actively involved in planning for development.

The responses to this [survey](#) will help us produce an effective toolkit and design better approaches for effective engagement between young people and the Planning Systems across the Commonwealth for Sustainable Development.

The Toolkit aims to give young people greater capacity to influence development issues, and to increase the awareness of sustainable development matters amongst young people on a multi-disciplinary basis.

It is anticipated that the blueprint of the toolkit will be presented at Commonwealth Heads of Government and Ministers meeting in June 2020.

The [Survey](#) is targeted at young people aged 15 – 30 and built environment professionals that have experience of working with youth people on planning and development issues. It will be open until 27th April 2020 whilst aggregate responses and analysis will be publicly released later this Summer.
